NIAGARA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE EXTEND INMATE HEALTH CARE SERVICES AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Sheriff's Office is responsible for providing medical care to inmates and detainees of the Niagara County Jail, including federal inmates, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara entered into an agreement with outside companies for the comprehensive correctional health care services to detainees and inmates who are lawfully remanded to the care, custody and under control of the Sheriff in accordance with applicable law, and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was entered into with the following Entities: Primecare Medical of New York, Inc., Buffalo Diagnostic Radiology, P.C., and Union Street Dentistry, PLLC, after the County issued a Request for Proposals, and

WHERESAS, Personalcare Registered Professional Nursing P.C., Professional Care Medical Practice PC., and Professional Care Dental Services PC, were substituted for Buffalo Diagnostic Radiology, P.C., and Union Street Dentistry, PLLC, by substitution executed August 3, 2017 and consented to August 4, 2017, and

WHEREAS, PrimeCare was instrumental during this rigorous accreditation process and they continually monitor and evaluate the standards. The Niagara County Jail medical accreditation is up in the fall of 2021 and the continuation of PrimeCare Medical will help the Niagara County Sheriff's Office to keep meeting the standards

set,

WHEREAS, there is no local or state law which requires a Request for Proposal on Professional Services, and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to enter into a new Agreement with Primecare Medical of New York, Inc., Personalcare Registered Professional Nursing PC, Professional Care Medical Practice PC, and Professional Care Dental Services PC., and

AUTHORIZATION TO CONVEY CERTAIN TAX LIEN PROPERTIES TO NORLIC

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 902 of the Real Property Tax Law ("RPTL") of the State of New York the Niagara County Treasurer, acting in his capacity as Tax Enforcing Officer, acquired tax liens on certain properties as follows: (1) Maple Avenue / S.B.L. No. 86.17-1-76; (2) Elizabeth Street / S.B.L. No. 86.17-1-75; (3) 23-25 Maple Avenue / S.B.L. No. 86.17-1-74; and (4) Cemetery Street / S.B.L. No. 86.17-1-73; and (5) Cemetery Street / S.B.L. No. 86.17-1-72 (collectively, the "Properties"), and

WHEREAS, the tax liens on the Properties are listed in the document attached as Exhibit A, and

WHEREAS, the Properties are abandoned industrial properties that require environmental remediation, and

WHEREAS, Section 1616 of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law of the State of New York authorizes a municipality to enter into a contract to sell some or all of the delinquent tax liens held by it to a land bank, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Treasurer has requested legislative approval to transfer the tax liens on the Properties to the Niagara Orleans Land Improvement Corporation ("NORLIC") with the understanding that the Properties will be remediated and developed by a private tax-paying purchaser, and

WHEREAS, the Properties, if foreclosed upon by the County of Niagara, are not needed for municipal purposes, and

WHEREAS, the benefits accruing the County of Niagara (avoidance of the costs of environmental remediation, demolition, and other expenses) are in excess of the potential auction value of the Properties, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, pursuant to County Law Section 215 and RPTL Section 902, the Chairman of the Niagara County Legislature be, and hereby is authorized and directed to sign and enter into a contract with NORLIC to sell the tax liens on the Properties for one and no more dollars and all other reasonable and necessary title transfer documents, subject to the review and approval of the Niagara County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, Pursuant to RPTL Section 1190(2)(a), the County Treasurer, as enforcement officer, shall, at least thirty (30) days prior to the date scheduled for the sale of the delinquent tax liens shall provide a notice, in the form provided by RPTL Section 1190(2)(b), along with any other information deemed necessary or required, by First Class and certified mail, to the owners of the Properties and any other person who has filed a declaration of interest pursuant to RPTL Section 1126, or a comparable instrument pursuant to a comparable law, which has not expired, and be it further

RESOLVED, that, upon NORLIC's purchase of the tax liens, the County Treasurer is authorized and directed under RPTL Section 1190(3) to convey the tax liens to NORLIC by delivering to NORLIC tax lien certificates identifying the affected parcels and the total amount due on each parcel as of the date of the sale, including interest, penalties, and charges. The County Treasurer shall retain a copy of each such certificate in his office, and shall maintain records that will enable interested parties to determine which liens have been sold, to whom, and the total amount due on such liens when they were sold, and be it further

RESOLVED that, upon sale, the affected tax district(s) shall have no further rights or responsibilities relative to delinquent tax liens which were sold under RPTL Section 1190(3).

WHEREAS, Resolution No. IF-071-20, dated June 16, 2020, authorized Change Order No. 2 to increase the contract in the amount of \$139,012.71 for the following: removal of tapered insulation and installation of flat insulation at the Ross Building; removal of tapered insulation in select roof areas and installation of flat insulation in those areas; removal of existing concrete curb and infill with steel deck at the Trott Building; replacement of roof top units 1-5 with new Trane units at the Trott Building; and replacement of air handler units 1-3 and refrigeration a/c coils at the Trott Building, for a revised contract amount of \$2,979,566.25, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. IF-086-20, dated August 4, 2020, authorized Change Order No. 3 to increase the contract in the amount of \$53,517.65 for the following work: reinforce structural steel supports at the Ross Building for two roof top units; add plywood to various parapets at the Trott Building; revise steel perimeter angle supports and repair a section of the parapet wall at the Ross Building; and install an additional parapet wall at the Ross Building, for a revised contract amount of \$3,033,083.90, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. IF-134-20, dated December 1, 2020, authorized Change Order #4 to decrease the contract in the amount of \$1,843.75 for: removal of tapered insulation and installation of flat insulation at the high roof of area C at the Trott Building; repair of drywall on a time and material basis at the Trott Building; and installation of a metal cap for the chimney no longer needed at the Ross Building, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to extend the contract for one-year, at no cost to the county, and to increase the contract in the amount of \$10,561.93 to add a roof drain to the Trott Building, for a revised contract amount of \$3,041,802.08, and

CARMEN ROAD BRIDGE OVER JOHNSON CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT FEDERAL AID LOCAL PROJECT AGREEMENT
